# + PRE-K & KINDERGARTEN



We offer full-day classes for:
Pre-K3 (3 years old by September 1)
Pre-K4 (4 years old by September 1)
Kindergarten (5 years old by September 1)

Our students learn using Abeka Curriculum designed specifically for these age groups. The structured phonics program teaches them to read from an early age. In addition to core curriculum, our students participate in library, music, PE, and chapel each week.



Our elementary-age students learn using a combination of curriculum from Abeka, Bob Jones University, and \*Accelerated Reader.

In addition to core curriculum—which includes Bible, reading, history, math, science, and English—our students participate in chapel and special classes each week, such as library, music, and PE.

\*Used as additional supplement to grade level reading.



Our 7th and 8th grade students learn using a combination of curriculum from Bob Jones University, including math or prealgebra, life and earth sciences, world studies, American Republic, English, Bible, STEM, and Reading Logic.

In addition to core curriculum, these students participate in weekly chapel, field trips throughout the year, and they have the chance to participate in our athletics program through a variety of sports.



Students in Grades 9-12 are offered two college preparatory tracks of study: College Prep and Academic Honors. Students in 11th and 12th grades also have the additional opportunity to participate in dual enrollment to gain college credit while in high school.

In addition to core curriculum, these students participate in weekly chapel, service projects, and are offered the chance to take part in academic electives, language courses, athletics, and other extracurricular activities.



All of our teachers (Grades K-12) hold a minimum of a bachelor's degree and are certified by both the Mid-South Association of Independent Schools (MAIS) and The Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). Our preschool teachers are also highly qualified and hold certification through MAIS.

Each teacher is a professing Christian and a part of a local church of their choice. Our faculty is not only committed to the overall academic advancement of our students, but also to the spiritual growth and development of each student.



Students in Grades 7-12 can choose to participate from a variety of sports offered at CCA and work together with their team to compete in interscholastic competitions.

Our students learn and refine so much more than physical skills. They develop leadership traits, gain courage and strength, exercise mental endurance, and experience competitive intensity while exhibiting generosity of spirit.

## Uniforms

All students are required to wear uniforms.

### **MEALS**

Pre-K and Kindergarten students eat lunch in their classrooms while students in grades 1-12 eat lunch in our cafeteria (additional snacks and drinks can be purchased at this time).
